

2020 Alaska Mission Team

King of Kings Alaska Mission team will be joining a mission team made up of people from Minnesota and Kansas.

The team is planning a two week trip. The first week July 13th through 17th the team will be traveling to Seward, Alaska to hold Vacation Bible School at Resurrection Lutheran Church for 65 to 80 children. They range in age from 4 through early teens. The team plans to use Rocky Railway VBS program from Group Publishing.

The team will stay at the church. Team members need to bring a sleeping pad and appropriate clothing for the week. The cost per person is your round trip air fare from MSP to Anchorage plus \$50 for food. As much of the trip cost as possible will be funded by Thrivent Action grants and fund raisers.

The second week would be in the Bush to help complete a Christian retreat center located on the big bend of the Yentna River. On July 18th the team will fly from Anchorage's float plane terminal to the camp on the Yentna River. In previous years the team has built cabins. This year they will build bunk beds. The team members will need a sleeping pad, bedding and appropriate clothing. All the tools and building materials will be supplied. Additional cost the second week, in addition to your round trip flight from MSP to Anchorage, would be \$260 per person for the float plane and \$50 for food.

You can participate in either or both weeks. The King of Kings contingent will leave MSP for Anchorage on July 10th. If you only participate in the first week you will return on July 18th arriving home on July 19th.

If you participate in the second week and not the first week, you would fly from MSP to Anchorage on July 17th and would return on July 25th arriving home July 26th.

If you participated both weeks, you would fly from MSP to Anchorage on July 10th. You would return from Anchorage on July 25th arriving home on July 26th.
