


Dear Praying Friends,

*I wish I could be sure that you are getting the newsletters that I send in the mail. I have mailed two letters to my daughter—in February and in April, and neither of them have arrived. Be sure that if I have your land address, but no email address for you, that I am mailing letters every month via the post office. If you have not received one each month, it has gotten lost in the mail.*

Covid-19 has arrived in Taiwan, and they have added numbers of locally infected each day...16, 29, 180, 206, 333, 240, 267.

Church musician Dr. Martin Dicke has been preparing a variety of presentations to offer the churches in Taiwan. The Eternal Song—how music was used throughout Scripture; The Psalms; The Tabernacle; The Temple; Lutheran Hymnody; Anna Magdalena Bach; and a piano workshop for church musicians.

I have been studying Chinese—words from the Old Testament tabernacle, the liturgy, music words and other vocabulary. All of this in preparation to interpret effectively for his presentations.

I have also practiced reading 28 pages of Scriptures from Dr. Dicke’s presentations to Chenhsi

Hanson, who was quarantining for two weeks in our building. She returned from Korea, and her sister from the USA, both because their father passed away.

Despite the sad circumstance which brought Chenhsi home, I have been exceedingly grateful to have her expert assistance in practicing for the presentations. She was able to give me some professional clues, too, to aid in the work. (Chenhsi has a Master’s degree in Translation and Interpretation.)

I have not been able to visit Mrs. Lee, (Chenhsi’s mom) since Mr. Lee died. His funeral will be held May 25<sup>th</sup>. Due to the Covid-19 outbreak, no public is allowed to attend the funeral. We continue to hold that family in prayer, especially that God’s comfort and salvation will be known there.

Nor have I been able to visit Mary, because she has been feeling sick, weak and tired since re-starting chemotherapy following her surgery. I send her Scriptures and prayers online, but many days she is too weak to get online. Please continue to hold Mary and her husband Steve, as well as the Mrs. Lee in prayer—for healing grace, and for eternal salvation.

Thank you for your prayers for God's work in Taiwan and these friends, and for your financial support. You are a blessing to me, and I thank God for you!
